HIST 103: Introduction to the Medieval World

This course is an overview of medieval history from the late Roman Empire to the birth of Renaissance Europe, encompassing the millennium from about 300 AD to 1500 AD. The course will explore political, religious, and social changes as well as economic, technological, and cultural developments. By the end of the course, students will gain a sophisticated understanding of the large historical processes that took place during the period and identify those that have been formative in the development of European Civilization. As we explore the themes of the course, students will also develop an awareness of the complexity of human experience of the men and women who inhabited the medieval world.
