

Guidelines for Preparing Your Proposal for Purdue Studies in Romance Literatures

Proposals may be prepared in English, Spanish, or French. We prefer a proposal of approximately three or four pages. You may send it either as a PDF attached to an email or in printed form. Word documents will not be accepted. A writing sample is not required, but may be requested at a later stage. To be considered, the manuscript must be completed. We do not consider manuscripts in progress.

The proposal should contain the following sections:

- 1. Your contact information
- 2. Title of the work
- 3. Length, in words and pages
- 4. Project description—overview
- 5. Table of contents
- 6. Description of chapters—be brief
- 7. Images in work, and whether permissions can be secured
- 8. Previously published sections and permissions
- 9. Contribution of the project to scholarship (e.g., first full-length study)
- 10.Expected market
- 11. Potential manuscript reviewers with academic affiliations
- 12.A short CV
