Through this program, we **match eligible CCSE Student Community Members with Purdue alumni from the Washington, DC area.**

We create opportunities for YOU to to connect and create professional relationships with Purdue alumni who are professionals in their field. Your mentor will help YOU learn about the wide range of career paths in our nation's capital and prepare for a successful career after graduation.

COMMITMENT

The program will begin the September 7, 2023 and will end April 30, 2023.

CCSE Student Community members will meet with their mentors at least one time per month and submit a meeting reflection before the 28th of each month. Members must attend at least 3 CCSE Student Community events each semester and 2 Career Insights sessions during the year.

MENTOR PAIRS

The number of mentor pairs will be dependent on the number of interested participants. Mentor pairs who were previously matched and would like to continue together into the next academic year's mentorship program may make that request to the program director.

- Be an active member of the CCSE Student Community in good standing with the group
- Be in good academic standing with Purdue University
