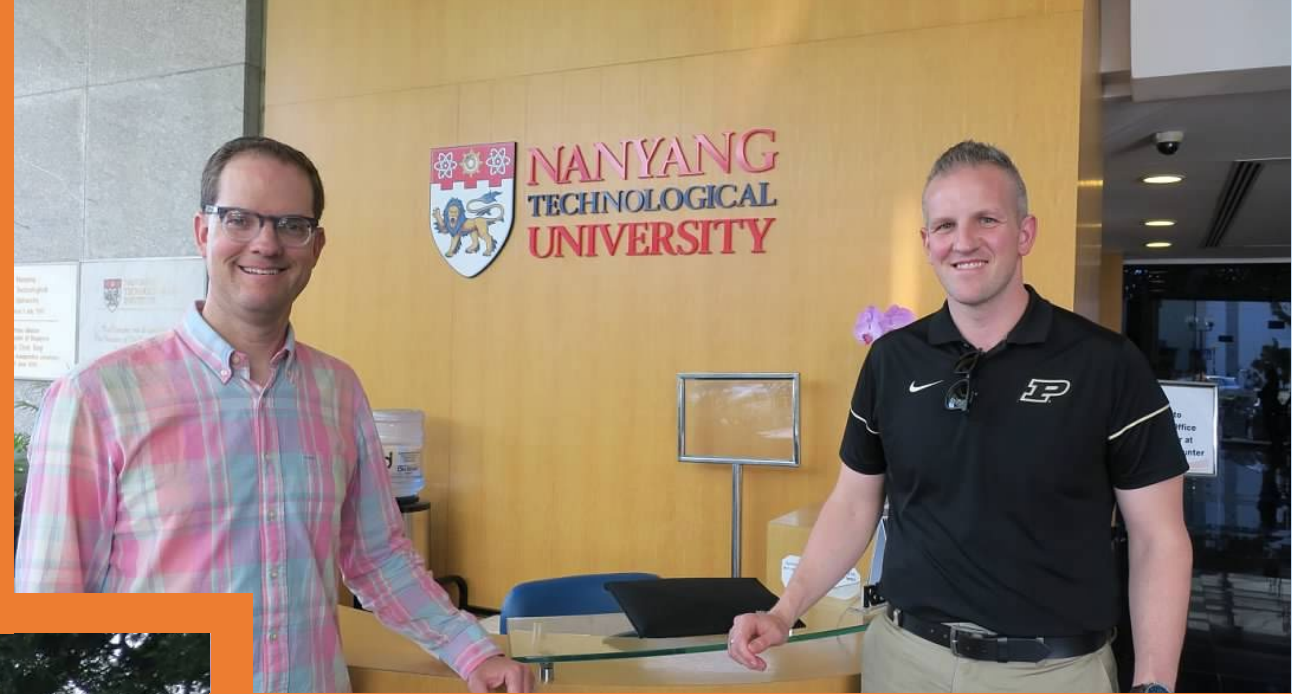




Singapore is a great place to study abroad in a fall or spring semester.

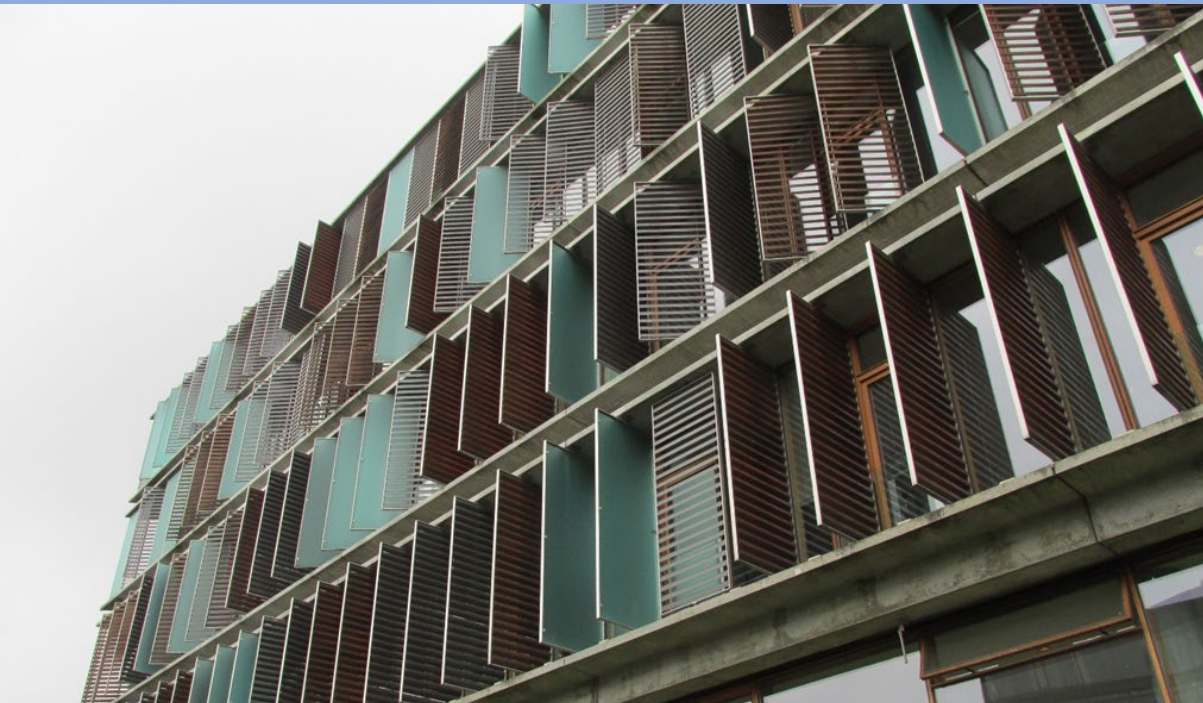

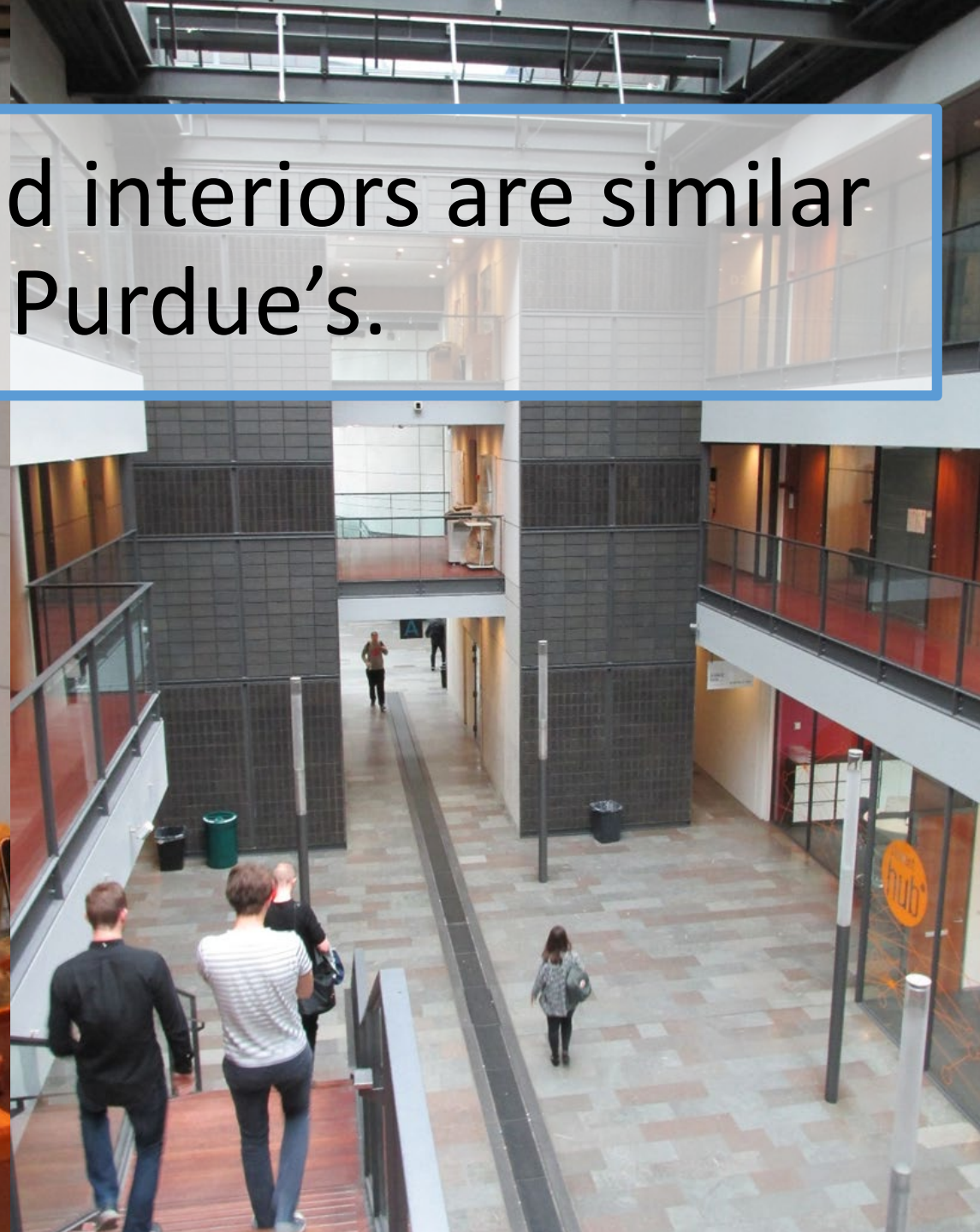

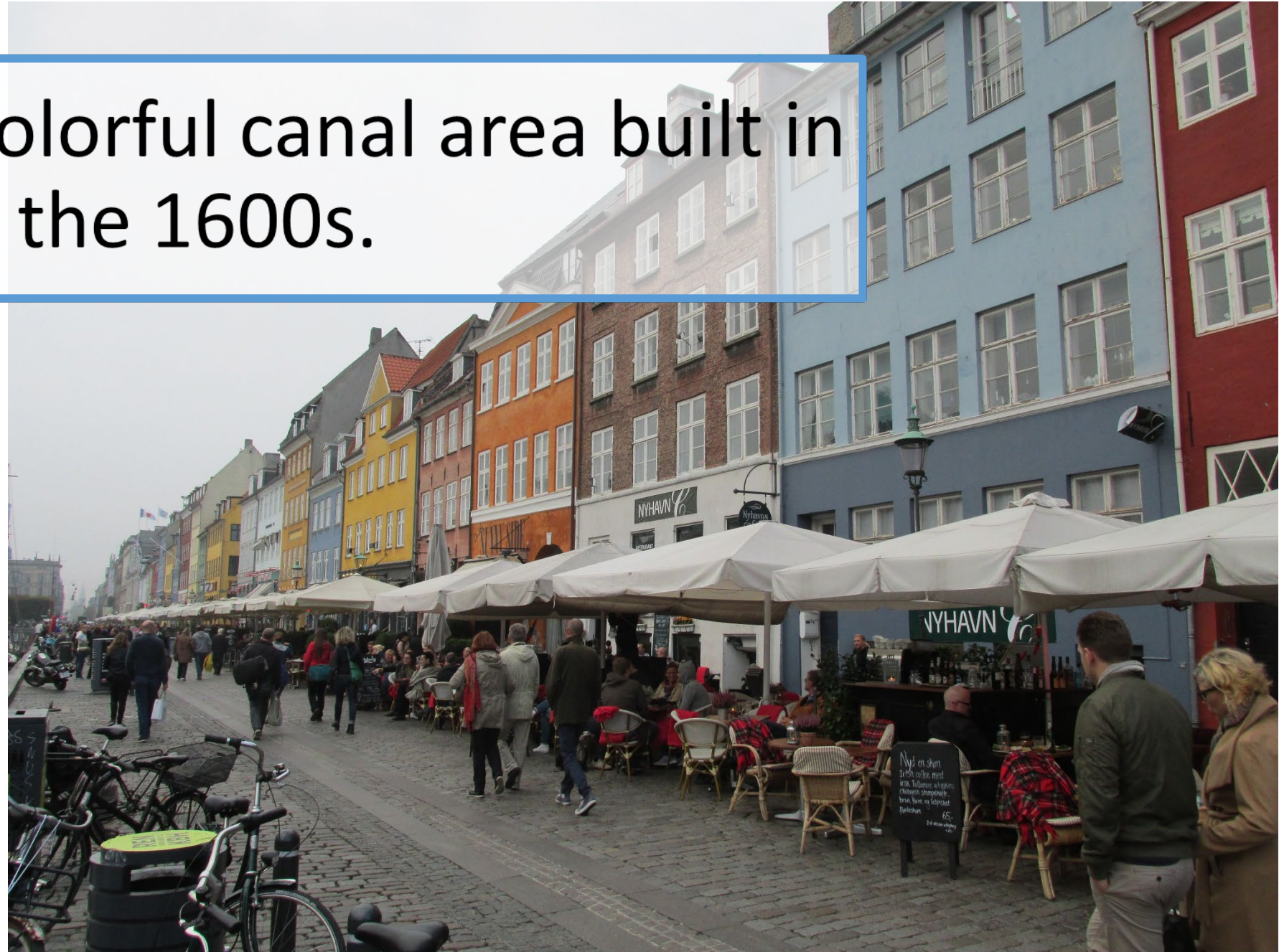
The city is filled with parks and history.

- On- and off-campus accommodations
- Three Metro stops on campus
- Bike-friendly
- Everyone speaks English
- Deadlines: Feb. 15 (for fall), Sept. 15 (for spring)
- Price: regular Purdue tuition
- Eligible for up to \$7000 in Purdue study abroad scholarships
- “Buddy system” with Danish partner upon arrival
- Top 10 business school in the world
- Student tip: say “yes” to all the first-week social events!

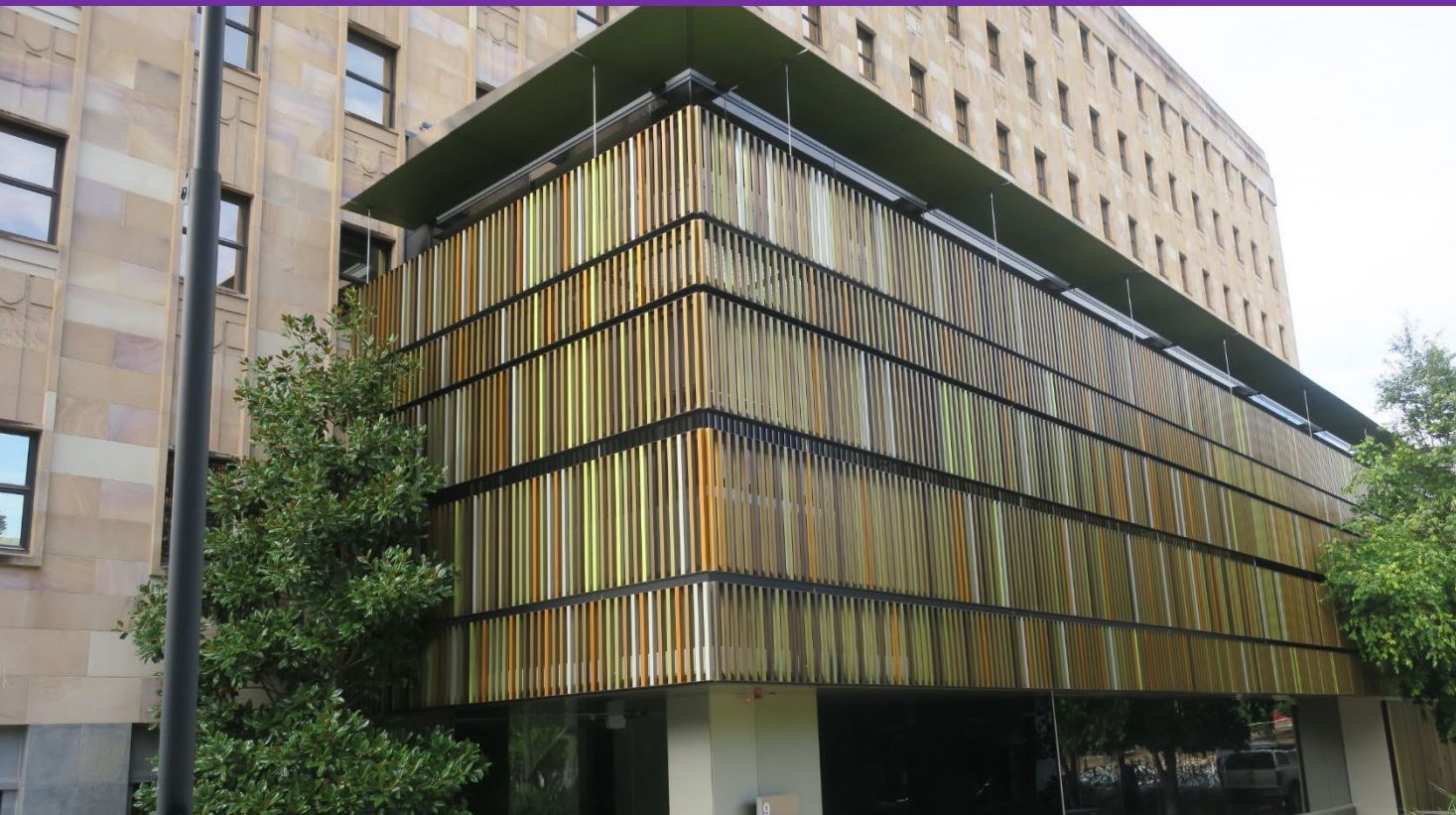
