**SUBJECT:** Reapportionment of Liberal Arts Senate for 2020-21

In compliance with Section 2.02 of the Liberal Arts By-Laws, the Senate must determine the apportionment of elected senators to Liberal Arts departments/schools (unit) each calendar year. The following is a proposed reapportionment for Senate consideration. If adopted, this representation would become effective on July 1, 2020.

This proposal is based on proportional representation according to the number of voting faculty, with the provision that no unit shall have fewer than two (2) senators. The total number of CLA senators is at 40 which includes 37 elected from 11 units, 2 from the Heads Council and 1 Dean.
