Purdue Test Score Cut-Offs for Graduate Admission to Purdue and for Certification of Oral English Proficiency

The chart below shows the cut-off scores (minimum acceptable scores) for Graduate Admission to Purdue, and the scores accepted for certification of oral English proficiency of TAs who teach undergraduate students, as of September, 2019.

It is important to note that the Graduate Admission TOEFL iBT cut-off score for speaking,18, is <u>significantly lower</u> than the cut-off score required for certification of oral English proficiency for TAs, currently 27 on the TOEFL iBT.
