

CLA Publication Subvention Program

Update 2017

With the support from the Office of the Vice President for Research, the College of Liberal Arts a publication subvention program. The goal of this program is to support faculty in meeting subsidy requirements of reputable presses' publication of high quality books.

In this arrangement, the department/school has provided 1/3 and upon the college's endorsement, OVPR has provided the remaining 2/3 of the subvention.

OVPR and CLA plans to continue this effort and ensure that all CLA faculty are aware of the program. The program will be reviewed annually. Please direct any questions about this program to Melissa Remis, Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Education (remis@purdue.edu).

Procedure:

- Faculty will submit their subvention requests to their department/school for head's approval.
- The request for subvention will include the following documents: (a) publisher's letter of acceptance and (b) publisher's letter indicating the amount of the subvention.
- Using criteria including the quality of the scholarship as reflected in the reputation of the publisher and whether the subvention is mandatory or not, department heads will make the decision to support the request at the departmental level by awarding 1/3 of the subvention.
- Subvention requests approved by departments will then be submitted to the Associate Dean for Research of the College. Along with the publisher's letters of acceptance and subvention request, heads will submit a letter indicating their commitment to providing 1/3 of the subvention.
- Upon endorsing the unit request, the college will request 2/3 of the subvention to OVPR.
